IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING UNION PARTICIPATION

As of January 2008, a \$500 annual WDA has been levied on all carpenters performing ninety nine (99) hours or above for a Union contractor in the jurisdiction of the New York City and Vicinity District Council of Carpenters.

Each active member must provide at least one day or seven (7) hours of Union activity (picketing, etc.). No exceptions will be made for failure to comply with this District Council By-Law, unless due to medical necessity.

The Union Activity department may be contacted at 212.366.7810 between the hours of 2 p.m. and 4 p.m. Monday - Friday to answer any questions you may have about this Union responsibility. You may also access information on upcoming union activity events by contacting this department. If you are a NYCDCC member you may access union activity information at www.nycdistrictcouncil.com.

Examples:

- 1. If you are initiated or reinstated in November 2019, and work 99 or above hours within the same calendar year, you must fulfill your Union participation duty by December 31, 2019.
- 2. If you are a UBC member of a non-NYCDCC local, and you are working in the jurisdiction of the NYCDCC at or above the 99-hour mark, you are required to adhere to the NYCDCC's policy and fulfill your Union participation duty for the NYCDCC by the end of the same calendar year in which the work was performed. This obligation is independent of any Union participation that you may be responsible for within your own local.
- 3. If you have worked 99 hours or above within a calendar year and are retiring within the same year, you are obligated to fulfill your Union participation duty within that same year.

Failure to fulfill Union Participation within a calendar year will result in a \$500 working dues. It is the responsibility of each member to keep track of hours worked per year.
